## SAFEGUARDING

... is Everyone's Responsibility

<b>Recognise</b>	the signs that could indicate that abuse might be happening to a child, young person or vulnerable adult.
<b>Respond</b>	sensitively to the person and listen to what they have to say. Do not ask closed questions or attempt to investigate.
<b>Record</b>	what you have been told factually and accurately, using the language used by the person disclosing within an hour.
<b>Report</b>	immediately to your Church Safeguarding Lead (CSL) who will know from whom to seek support.
<b>Refer</b>	to your CSL, the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser (DSA) (contact details below); and the appropriate statutory authorities.

In an **emergency** situation where there is an **immediate risk of harm** to a child or vulnerable person: **call 999**
