SAFEGUARDING

... is Everyone's Responsibility

Recognise	the signs that could indicate that abuse might be happening to a child, young person or vulnerable adult.
Respond	sensitively to the person and listen to what they have to say. Do not ask closed questions or attempt to investigate.
Record	what you have been told factually and accurately, using the language used by the person disclosing within an hour.
Report	immediately to your Parish Safeguarding Officer (PSO) who will know from whom to seek support.
Refer	to your CSL, the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser (DSA) (contact details below); and the appropriate statutory authorities.

In an **emergency** situation where there is an **immediate risk of harm** to a child or vulnerable person: **call 999**
